Who We Are

Founded in July 2011, the Melbourne AWS User Group is Australia's oldest Amazon Web Servicesfocused user group, and the eight oldest such group in the world. From the original seven attendees in Melbourne's York Butter Factory, we now regularly host meetups with 100+ attendees at our regular venue, as well as regular special events in the Melbourne AWS office. With over 4000 group members, we are amongst the 20 largest cityspecific AWS user groups in the world.

The Meetup

Each meetup typically kicks off with an introduction that compromises the night's agenda, venue information for new attendees and a thank you to our sponsors.

This is followed by a short news segment that covers recent AWS and User Group announcements as well as a look at what other AWS-related events are coming up. Our first speaker then gets approximately 30 minutes to bedazzle the audience before our Marketplace Segment, which is a chance to promote any open AWSrelated job vacancies to the group, and sponsor's get priority. This leads into refreshments and networking, the perfect opportunity to talk about your presentation or job vacancies. After the break its on to the second presentation or lightning talks before wrapping up the night.


The Venue
